Midwife Appointments

Speak to your midwife to book an appointment.

Come Talk with Me - Term Time Only

For children aged 24-36 months, supporting parents who have concerns with their child's speech and language development. Referral only.

Parenting Puzzle

A programme which helps parents to develop their parenting skills covering many topics such as why children behave as they do, recognising feelings, approaches to discipline and building co operation.

Play and Learn - (under 5's)

Queens Park sessions must be booked by calling the centre up to 2 days in advance Tuesdays)

Play and Learn is a fun session for children from 0-5 years. Explore activities and new experiences together, designed to support your child's interests, creativity and learning needs. Take away great ideas to try at home too! Our friendly, experienced team will also give you advice, guidance and information in lots of other areas and share with you other activities that you can enjoy together in your local community.

Ready, Steady, Go! - Term Time Only

Ready, Steady, Go! Will help you support your child to become 'life ready'. With a focus on physical development, confidence, self-esteem, 'school readiness' and improving social skills. Referral only.

Introduction to Solids

An opportunity for parents to find out strategies to wean their babies to a milk and food diet, recommended for parents of babies between 4 and 6 months.

Childminders - Term Time Only

A Play & Learn session for Ofsted registered Childminders supporting early years children with their learning and development.

Lets Cook - Term Time Only

5 week course. Learn to prepare easy meals for the family using fresh ingredients.

Antenatal Classes

Run by midwives, there will be 2 sessions. The first covering labour and birth and the second covering breast feeding.
